Auditor Edelen receives national honor from prominent technology magazine

FRANKFORT, Ky. (Feb. 28, 2014) – Auditor Adam Edelen has been named one of Government Technology’s Top 25 Doers, Dreamers & Drivers for 2014. The award is given annually to leaders making government both more efficient and more effective. The Auditor will be featured in the March issue of Government Technology and in a video on govtech.com.

Auditor Edelen was recognized for the creation of his Citizen Auditor database, which provided greater transparency over special taxing districts such as libraries, sanitation districts and fire departments. He also was recognized for creating a digital SAFEhouse to enable citizens to securely and anonymously submit tips of waste, fraud, and abuse to the Auditor’s office and his current efforts to pass a cyber breach notification law in the 2014 legislative session.

“My administration has worked hard to incorporate as many cutting edge technologies as possible into nearly every aspect of the work we do on behalf of taxpayers,” Auditor Edelen said. “So it’s certainly a great honor to be recognized for our efforts.”

Auditor Edelen was the only state Auditor to receive the award.
