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Auditor Harmon Announces Change for March 26th Meeting of State Committee for School District Audits

Changes due to ongoing COVID-19 emergency in Kentucky

FRANKFORT, Ky. (March 23, 2020) – State Auditor Mike Harmon announced today, in accordance with Kentucky’s Open Meetings Law (KRS 61.820), changes to the scheduled March 26 meeting of the State Committee for School District Audits.

The meeting scheduled for March 26 is cancelled due to the ongoing COVID-19 emergency in Kentucky. Because of the situation, under KRS 61.823, a special meeting of the State Committee for School District Audits will take place at 11 a.m. on March 26. The meeting will be conducted via teleconference in accordance with KRS 61.826.

Due to the Governor’s executive order closing state buildings to the public, the public is invited to attend the meeting electronically by Skype by utilizing the following link at the time of the meeting: <https://meet.lync.com/kymsoffice/farrah.petter/JCZ6FYNZ>.

The Committee, formed by the Kentucky General Assembly, is in charge of ensuring that each school district board of education is audited once every fiscal year. In addition to the State Auditor, members of the Committee include representatives of the Governor, Attorney General, Legislative Research Commission’s Office of Educational Accountability, and the Commissioner of Education.

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
